We are changing the publisher and the platform for the submission and revision of manuscripts, which will be performed under the supervision of a dedicated publisher, Permanyer Portugal, with whom we intend to keep a fruitful collaboration toward the indexation of the Portuguese Journal of Dermatology in PubMed Central.

Furthermore, we count on our editorial board and all regular collaborators to keep the scientific level of the publications.
